Environmental Stewardship & the Quarry Innovation Center

San Bruno Mountain is the heart of Brisbane.

The threat to rare butterflies on San Bruno Mountain is real, as open grassland habitat gets “taken over” by coyote brush and invasive weeds. In order to keep grassland habitat for butterflies, the County of San Mateo’s Habitat Conservation Plan regularly removes invasive scrub on the mountain, with the help of contractors and nonprofit organizations.

As part of our commitment to environmental stewardship, we’ve pledged an initial payment of \$1.8 million to the Habitat Conservation Plan to help fund removing invasive scrub to save butterfly habitat. In addition to the initial payment to the HCP, we will make annual payments, in perpetuity, and expect to be largest single contributor to the HCP.

We are committed to the Quarry Innovation Center being a place where both the environment *and* business thrive.
