Protecting San Bruno Mountain for the Long Term



A Landscape Worth Protecting

San Bruno Mountain is one of the Bay Area's most important conservation landscapes, supporting rare native plants and federally protected butterfly species. It is also home to the nation's first Habitat Conservation Plan, a model for conservation that helped shape similar efforts across the country.



The Work of Conservation Continues

While decades of conservation work have achieved significant success, important habitat management challenges remain. Protecting the mountain for the long term requires active management, restoration, monitoring, and ongoing stewardship, all of which require reliable, long-term funding.



From Quarry Operations to Long-Term Stewardship

As part of development, the Quarry Innovation Center would permanently end a 130-year-old mining operation, begin the long-term reclamation of a heavily disturbed industrial site, and provide significant new resources to support implementation of the San Bruno Mountain HCP.
